#### **Program**

Lion Don Smith introduced Col. Don Fallin, US Army retired, and is a Cullman-area native, He spoke to us about the Cullman Veterans Hall of Fame (HOF) project, which he has led for several years. Lion Don pointed out that Col. Fallin has been our speaker a couple of times before.

Col. Falin was most appreciative of our Club's generous past support to the Veterans HOF, stating that our Club was its top supporter last year. With this in mind he brought with him a thank-you card and notice of a plague that is being prepared for our Club to commemorate this support. He said his intention was to keep his remarks short in light of his last visits to highlight the Veterans HOF. He said the hardest thing that he's encountered in running the HOF induction ceremony is getting the nominations. trying each year to make it easier and easier. He had several nomination packets that he made available tonight to Lions for their possible inputs for nominations to recognize our community's heroes. Don reminded us that the HOF selection committee consists of rotating

members representatives from the VFW, the American Legion, and the Disabled American Veterans (DAV). Other members include community leaders such as Commissioner Gary Marchman, CEO of Cullman Savings Bank -- Mr. John Riley, and others. Col. Fallin mentioned that last year, he went out to a potential member's house and help him in typing out a HOF nomination form for him, because he knew that the man was a very qualified candidate. Last year one officer and five enlisted veterans were selected for induction into the Cullman Veterans HOF (two were posthumous). HOF heroes, along with their families, are honored and recognized at the HOF dinner, with a plaque posted on the courthouse wall for a year & returned to them or their family, and their names are added to a perpetual list of former inductees which is also displayed at the Cullman Court House. Finally, a paver with their name and year of induction is placed in the Cullman Veterans Memorial Park at Sportsman Lake.

A letter from the LICF President was read, commemorating Lion Seybold. Lion Brooks then called up Lion Fred Osborne to present him with his 55 years of service, Lion pin chevron award. Finally, Lion Brooks then called up Lion Howard Perry to present him with his 35 years of service, Lion pin chevron award.

Lion Craig Gadow read BOD minutes from 10-21-24. Funding was approved for donations to the Boone Lions Club in Kentucky, following its recent tornado disaster, and to Wreaths Across America.
