Lion Randy Kraft introduced Commander Brian Monk of the Cullman VFW, noting that the Commander has 17 years of service in the US Army and has 6 kids and also serves as the Deputy Coroner for Cullman County.



Commander Brian Monk of the Cullman VFW, presented with our Club token of appreciation from Lion President Chris Brooks, with Mr. Sean Schofield and Lion Randy Kraft to their left.

Commander Monk talked about activities surrounding Veterans Day, coming up on Monday, Nov. 11th. The VFW will be setting out US flags on the highway from Vinemont past Tractor Supply, which will stay out until Nov. 12th. His group will have a booth out at the Cullman Airport for the Veterans Day airshow & celebration. He said the VFW tries to help with groceries, transportation, wheelchairs, or whatever is needed to assist vets. The next big event for the VFW after that will be providing Vet with a free Thanksgiving meal at the Branding Iron Steakhouse in West Point on the Monday before Thanksgiving; every year it feeds about 1300 veterans and their families. The VFW also collaborates with the Sheriff's Department in delivering these meals to house-bound veterans.

Brian stated that anyone can call him if they wish to donate turkeys and hams.

Brian then introduced Mr. Sean Schofield who talked about another event that the VFW is helping to sponsor, "Toys for Tots," which will be headed up by Sean and his wife this year. He began by thanking the Club in supporting his religious mission to Ukraine a couple of years ago and in support the use of a fairground building for the Toys for Tots event this year in storing, organizing, cataloging, then packaging gifts for distribution. He said their mission is to give hope to indigent children on Christmas, which otherwise might not happen. He said that in the past this event has been shared with Cullman, Lawerence, and Morgan counties, but this year Cullman will have its own program. He said that this means that all the money and gifts collected will stay here in Cullman for its children. He said that he is trying to work with Churches and charity & social services organization within Cullman. Sean invited Club members to participate in helping and in providing potential families' contact info for their consideration in receiving gifts for their children.

The men who spoke to us this evening are great examples of those who also following our Club's moto of service and making our community great.

Lion Howard Perry was in attendance with us tonight after several weeks absence due to issues related to his heart.

Lion Javon Daniel was absent tonight, also with heart issues. His doctor advised him to rest and refrain from any strenuous activities and take

Lion Milford said that he had contacted the head nurse for the County schools, who told him just to bring the supplies to her and that she would distribute them to all the County schools as she makes her regular visits.

Lion Bill Ruehl called for another round of Lion support for the Lion's Sight van in making another call at the Good Samaritan Clinic. He invited Lions to drop by this Wednesday just to see how these visits are conducted and appreciated.

Lion Frank Odell announced another new Lion roundtable session tonight and said that Lion Ginger Hogeland, who just finished all her new Lion sessions, would be the presenter for tonight's session.
